- 19 (d) (1) In this subsection, "Deer Management Permit" means a permit issued 20 by the Department authorizing the holder or an agent of the holder to hunt deer outside of 21 deer hunting season for the purpose of preventing damage to crops.

 HARFORD COUNTY, an individual who hunts deer under a Deer Management Permit

1 (i) Use a shotgun or breech loading center fired rifle approved by $\mathbf{2}$ the Department to hunt deer throughout the year, including all deer hunting seasons, in 3 the locations and under the conditions set forth in the permit; and 4 On State land in Charles County, Calvert County, [or] St. Mary's (ii) $\mathbf{5}$ County, OR HARFORD COUNTY leased by the permit holder for the purpose of cultivating 6 crops, hunt deer on the leased land in the locations and under the conditions set forth in 7the permit. 8 To protect public safety and welfare, the Department may restrict the (3)lands on which an individual may hunt deer under a Deer Management Permit. 9 10(4) (i) This paragraph applies only in Frederick County. 11 (ii) Subject to the conditions set forth in a Deer Management Permit, 12a permittee may use a rifle approved by the Department to harvest deer throughout the 13year, including all deer hunting seasons. In Frederick County Zone 1, as defined in COMAR 14(iii) 1508.03.03.06A.(3)(g), an agent of a permittee may use a rifle to harvest deer throughout the 16year. 17(iv) 1. This subparagraph applies only in Frederick County Zone 2, as defined in COMAR 08.03.03.06A.(3)(h). 1819 2.Except as provided in subsubparagraph 3 of this 20subparagraph, an agent of a permittee may use a rifle to harvest deer in a period beginning 21October 1 and ending March 31. 223. In a deer firearms season, an agent of a permittee may 23harvest deer only by using the weapon approved for that season. 24(v) The Department shall adopt regulations to implement this 25subsection. 26SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 271, 2019.
