45	(b) (1) Subject to paragraph (2) of this subsection, the license authorizes the license holder to sell beer at retail:
6 7	(I) at the place described in the license for [on– and off–premises] ON–PREMISES consumption; AND
8 9	(II) AT THE DISCRETION OF THE BOARD, FOR OFF–PREMISES CONSUMPTION.
10	(2) A license may not be issued for a drugstore.
11	(c) The annual license fee is \$250.
