- 18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

- 22 (A) BEGINNING IN THE 2020–2021 SCHOOL YEAR, A COUNTY BOARD SHALL
- 23 PROVIDE AGE-APPROPRIATE INSTRUCTION ON ORGAN AND TISSUE DONATION AND
- 24 REGISTRATION AS PART OF THE PERSONAL AND CONSUMER HEALTH CURRICULUM
- 25 IN GRADES 9 THROUGH 12 IN PUBLIC HIGH SCHOOLS IN THE COUNTY.

1	(B)	THE PURPOSES AND GOALS OF THE INSTRUCTION ARE TO:

- 2 (1) DESCRIBE THE BENEFITS OF ORGAN AND TISSUE DONATION TO 3 THE GREATER SOCIETY AND TO THE HEALTH AND WELL-BEING OF THE INDIVIDUALS
- 4 WHOSE LIVES ARE SAVED BY THE DONATIONS; AND
- 5 (2) EXPLAIN THE OPTIONS AVAILABLE TO MINORS AND ADULTS 6 REGARDING ORGAN AND TISSUE DONATION, INCLUDING MATTERS CONCERNING:
- 7 (I) THE CIRCUMSTANCES THAT REQUIRE THE WRITTEN 8 CONSENT AND AUTHORITY OF PARENTS AND LEGAL GUARDIANS; AND
- 9 (II) THE OPTION FOR AN INDIVIDUAL TO DESIGNATE AND 10 GRANT TO A DECISION MAKER THE AUTHORITY TO MAKE ORGAN AND TISSUE 11 DONATION DECISIONS ON BEHALF OF THE INDIVIDUAL.
- 12 (C) A NONPUBLIC HIGH SCHOOL IS ENCOURAGED TO PROVIDE 13 AGE-APPROPRIATE INSTRUCTION ON ORGAN AND TISSUE DONATION AND 14 REGISTRATION IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS SECTION.
 - SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, during the 2019–2020 school year, a county board of education is encouraged to provide age—appropriate instruction on organ and tissue donation and registration as part of the personal and consumer health curriculum in grades 9 through 12 in public schools in the county in accordance with the purposes and goals established in § 7–446(b) of the Education Article, as enacted by Section 1 of this Act.
- 21 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 22 1, 2019.
