SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 BEGINNING IN THE 2020–2021 SCHOOL YEAR, EACH COUNTY BOARD SHALL 17 REQUIRE EACH PUBLIC ELEMENTARY SCHOOL IN THE COUNTY TO PROVIDE 18 HANDWRITING INSTRUCTION THAT ENABLES STUDENTS TO DEVELOP:

- 19(1)LEGIBLE PRINT HANDWRITING BY THE END OF THE THIRD GRADE;20AND
- 21 (2) LEGIBLE CURSIVE HANDWRITING BY THE END OF THE FIFTH 22 GRADE.

1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 2 1, 2019.
