- 18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 19 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Labor and Employment

22 (a) In this subtitle the following words have the meanings indicated.

- (h) (1) "Strategic industry partnership" means a collaboration that brings together a regional group that may include employers, nonprofits, institutions of higher education, community colleges, local boards, local governments, or other relevant partners to:
- 5 **[**(1)**] (I)** identify common workforce needs for high-demand occupations 6 within a target industry; and
- 7 **[**(2)**] (II)** develop and implement industry strategies to meet the common 8 workforce needs and shortages based on regional needs.
- 9 **(2)** "STRATEGIC INDUSTRY PARTNERSHIP" INCLUDES 10 REPRESENTATIVES OF:
- 11 (I) EMPLOYERS FROM THE TARGET INDUSTRY; AND
- 12 (II) REPRESENTATIVES OF LABOR ORGANIZATIONS 13 ASSOCIATED WITH THE TARGET INDUSTRY.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2019.
