correction of a drainage defect under certain circumstances; defining certain terms;
providing for a delayed effective date; and generally relating to drainage defects in
new homes in Prince George's County.

- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 2 October 1, 2020.
