## Rural Public Institutions of Higher Education – Nurse Practitioner and Physician Assistant Students – Recruitment

4 FOR the purpose of requiring each public institution of higher education located in a rural 5 area of the State to develop and implement a program to recruit nurse practitioner 6 students and physician assistant students; requiring the program to include an 7 implementation strategy and a certain timeline; requiring each institution to submit 8 a summary of the program to the governing body of the institution for review on or 9 before a certain date each year; requiring the governing body of the institution to submit a certain progress report to the Maryland Higher Education Commission on 10 11 or before a certain date each year; and generally relating to the recruitment of nurse 12 practitioner students and physician assistant students to public institutions of 13 higher education located in rural areas.

- 25 RECRUIT NURSE PRACTITIONER STUDENTS AND PHYSICIAN ASSISTANT STUDENTS.



- 1 (2) A PROGRAM DEVELOPED AND IMPLEMENTED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION SHALL INCLUDE AN IMPLEMENTATION STRATEGY AND A TIMELINE FOR MEETING THE GOALS OF THE PROGRAM.
- 4 (B) (1) ON OR BEFORE JULY 1 EACH YEAR, EACH INSTITUTION SHALL SUBMIT A SUMMARY OF THE PROGRAM DEVELOPED UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION TO THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE INSTITUTION FOR THE GOVERNING BODY'S REVIEW.
- 8 (2) ON OR BEFORE SEPTEMBER 1 EACH YEAR, THE GOVERNING BODY
  9 OF AN INSTITUTION SHALL SUBMIT A PROGRESS REPORT REGARDING THE
  10 INSTITUTION'S IMPLEMENTATION OF ITS PROGRAM TO THE COMMISSION.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2019.
