- SECTION 9. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, notwithstanding any other provision of law:
- 17 (a) Subject to subsection (b) of this section, for fiscal year 2015, funds in the Maryland Health Insurance Plan Fund established under § 14–504 of the Insurance Article 19 may be used by the [Department of Health and Mental Hygiene] **MARYLAND** 20 **DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH** to fund provider reimbursements in the Medicaid program.
- 21 (b) The amount of funds that may be used under subsection (a) of this section 22 shall be the greater of:

1 (1) \$55,000,000; or

- 2 (2) The estimated percentage of the fund balance obtained from payers 3 other than the federal Medicare program or the Medicaid program.
 - (c) [(1) Except as provided in paragraph (2) of this subsection, the] **THE** remaining fund balance obtained from the federal Medicare program or the Medicaid program may be used in fiscal years [2016 through 2019] **2020 THROUGH 2022** to support integrated care networks designed to reduce health care expenditures and improve outcomes for unmanaged high–needs Medicare patients and patients dually eligible for Medicaid and Medicare, consistent with the goals of Maryland's [all–payer] **TOTAL COST OF CARE** model.
- [(2) \$90,000 of the remaining fund balance obtained from the federal Medicare program or the Medicaid program may be used in fiscal years 2016 and 2017 to support the remaining expenses of the Maryland Health Insurance Plan.]
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2019.
