This project spans 6 different locations in Montgomery & Prince George's Counties: MONTGOMERY:

- Rockville Welcome Center (14645 Rothgeb Dr., Rockville, MD) the county licenses the space to CASA. Total technology improvements at this center is \$16,000.
- Wheaton Welcome Center (11425 Grandview Ave, Silver Spring, MD) the county licenses the space to CASA. Total technology improvements at this center is \$14.656.
- Pine Ridge Center (8615 Piney Branch Rd, Silver Spring, MD) CASA has a lease with Kay Management. Total technology improvements at this center is \$16,085.
- Silver Spring Welcome Center (734 University Blvd. E. Silver Spring, MD) CASA has a lease with the County. Total technology improvements at this center is \$14,556.

PRINCE GEORGE'S:

- Prince George's Welcome Center (7978-B New Hampshire Avenue, Langley Park, MD) CASA has a lease with Reliable Properties, LLC. Total technology improvements at this center is \$23,605.
- Multicultural Center (8151 15th Avenue, Langley Park, MD) CASA owns this property. Total technology improvements at this center is \$165,125.
