Specifically these funds will be used to continue installation of interior and exterior fire rated doors, installation of fire rated ceilings in closets, upgrade of alarm monitoring systems and acquisition of modern refrigeration and HVAC systems. Equally important is that these changes will reduce energy usage and as a result improve environmental quality in Prince Georges County. (see Comments for additional information)
