<p>Carrollton Hall, Inc. is a 501(c)3 not-for-profit organization founded by the Franciscan Friars Conventual to share the legacy of Charles Carroll of Carrollton, the only Catholic signer of the Declaration of Independence and the first Senator from the State of Maryland, in a restored Carrollton Hall, a home built by Charles Carroll in 1832. Carrollton Hall will offer permanent exhibits on the life of Charles Carroll, rotating exhibits on issues related to his legacy, annual programming like lectures and conferences, and premium conference space. As faithful stewards of this important piece of history, Carrollton Hall, Inc. will restore Carrollton Hall to its 19th century splendor and share its rich historic and cultural significance to the rest of Maryland and the United States.</p>		

11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit length to visible area)

The full restoration of Carrollton Hall entails: Historic restoration of the building's roof and exterior, including reconstruction of the four original chimneys, construction of replacement dormers, reconstruction of the original historic cupola, and re-pointing entire structure; restoration of all interior spaces including basement, first, second, and third floors; creation of permanent exhibits on the life and legacy of Charles Carroll, including his contribution to the Revolutionary War and Maryland's Declaration of Rights, as well as the contribution of enslaved persons on his property; and creation of conference space. In addition to presenting permanent and special exhibits on the life and legacy of Charles Carroll, Carrollton Hall will present talks, lectures, and conferences on the issues of liberty, justice, and the common good to which Charles devoted his life.
