Citywide Youth Development's mission is to provide relief of the poor, distressed, and underprivileged by encouraging entrepreneurship education, providing vocational skill training, and establishing enterprise development. Our goal is to utilize entrepreneurship and manufacturing as a crime prevention, poverty eradication, and community revitalization strategy. Citywide Youth Development is a non-profit established in 2010. Citywide Youth's current program partners include Under Armour and Sagamore Development. To date Citywide has created over 100 entrepreneurship and job opportunities, established 3 youth-run enterprises.

The EMAGE Center will help Citywide to achieve its goal of utilizing entrepreneurship and manufacturing as a crime prevention, poverty eradication, and community revitalization strategy. The EMAGE Center will have 3 purposes: manufacturing/skill training, enterprise development \*Made In Bmore Clothing Manufacturing facilities will occupy 3-4000 sqft. Annually 75-100 participants will be trained and or employed in this industrial apparel manufacturing program. \* Frozen Desert Sorbet has created over 100 spring/summer job opportunities for Baltimore City youth. FDS will occupy 3000 sqft of the EMAGE Center for sorbet production/packaging, cart storage space and also have a small retail sorbet shop open to the public. \*EMAGE Mall will be a retail presence in the center and will be a retail incubator for up to 12 small businesses. Each business enterprise will have a small 200-300 sqft shop in the space.

Citywide Youth Development's temporary home is currently located in Port Covington in a 4000 sqft space donated by program partner Weller Development. The EMAGE Center will be revolutionary in terms of importance to Baltimore City creating 100 job opportunities by year 2 and 200 job by year 5. There is currently not an economic development center of this kind catering to provide manufacturing skills, entrepreneurship, jobs, hope, and an positive images of young adults in Baltimore. Citywide has already established proven models and scaled the programs that will be located in this facility. This includes a fashion brand and retail store Made In BMore Clothing located in the Towson Town Center, CityWide Screen printing & Embroidery that partners with the Baltimore City and Under Armour, and Frozen Desert Sorbet the largest mobile cart company in Maryland (20 to date). In addition, the relationships with Under Armour, Weller Development, City Of Baltimore, and Baltimore Orioles are already underway. This center will just provide a permanent home for program operations and for expansion opportunities in the place that needs them most West Baltimore.
