#### **10. Description and Purpose of Organization** (Limit length to visible area)

EveryMind strengthens communities and empowers individuals to reach optimal mental wellness. EveryMind works with low-income and underserved populations to improve mental wellness through case management and counseling, peer navigation to veterans, support to atrisk students and their families, crisis prevention and intervention and community education. A trusted mental health resource in the National Capital Region since 1957, EveryMind offers programs and services that bring healing, hope and wholeness to children, youth, adults, veterans and families. From intensive case management services in schools, our life-saving crisis prevention and intervention work, or community education and advocacy, EveryMind positively impacts hundreds of area residents every week. Last year, EveryMind served 16,000 individuals in the region with 115,000 hours of direct support.

The project will provide critical and necessary renovations to EveryMind's headquarters, including installing a new roof, siding, gutters and new energy efficient windows. All programs and services originate at this location, which also houses all business operations. The building houses 24/7 life-saving services for the community including the Montgomery County crisis hotline and the supporting electronic infrastructure that enables staff and volunteers to answer incoming phone calls and connect with public safety officials when needed. Staff, community members and service recipients use this facility for day to day operations, meetings and service delivery. While EveryMind serves the entire County, our programs have historically targeted the most vulnerable and low-income residents. Our request for capital improvements are critical to the organization's ongoing ability to provide programs and services in a safe, secure physical environment.

Funding will allow EveryMind to provide critical and necessary renovations. Our headquarters house 24/7 life-saving services for the community including the Montgomery County crisis hotline and the supporting electronic infrastructure that enables staff and volunteers to answer incoming phone calls and connect with public safety officials when needed. Staff, community members and service recipients use this facility for day-to-day operations, meetings and service delivery.

Other programs that are directed from this location include, but are not limited to, the following:

ServingTogether is EveryMind's commitment to those who have served our country. There are more than 300,000 veterans in the National Capital Region. Many struggle to transition back to civilian life and approximately 53% face unemployment upon return. Our goal is to support them by coordinating a network of resources to help ensure they access and receive the services they need. ServingTogether provides resource coordination and improves the ease of navigation of services to optimize outcomes for veterans, service members and their families throughout the region.

EveryMind's direct services reach nearly 500 vulnerable, low-income adults every year. Case management services provide support to both homeless and formerly homeless individuals in Montgomery County, including assistance obtaining federal and state benefits. Ongoing case management helps ensure clients maintain self-sufficiency and remain stably housed, preventing a return to homelessness. For homeless individuals, EveryMind provides intensive case management services focused on engagement, needs assessments, access to benefits and entitlements and connections to shelter or permanent housing.

EveryMind's adult counseling services help low-income, vulnerable individuals, including immigrants and refugees, increase self-esteem, improve relationships and develop positive coping skills. EveryMind's bilingual and bicultural clinicians use evidence-based treatment modalities to improve the well-being of clients, many of whom have experienced significant trauma. Counseling services are available for individuals without insurance as well as those insured with Medicaid to ensure low-income Montgomery County residents can access the services they need to reach optimal mental wellness.

EveryMind is one of the regions leading providers of Mental Health First Aid (MHFA), an eight-hour, evidence-based training taught by certified instructors designed to increase mental health literacy. EveryMind implements trainings in the youth, adult and military modules of MHFA. MHFA teaches participants how to intervene when someone is experiencing a mental health crisis and help provide the appropriate assistance. MHFA provides tools to address mental health and substance use needs, increasing the regions capacity to respond and strengthening whole communities while tackling a nationwide epidemic.

EveryMind has a network of 500 volunteers who provide additional capacity and help us serve hundreds of residents annually.
