10. Description and Purpose of Organization (Limit length to visible area)					

Garrett College is a small, rural, two-year community college located in western Maryland. Its principal service area is Garrett County, Maryland (population approximately 30,000). Garrett College offers both workforce development classes and credit coursework leading to an Associates degree. Its central location in a rural environment makes the college a hub for public events and activities, allowing the college to contribute to its community by serving residents, businesses, public schools, and nonprofit organizations.

11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit length to visible area)

Garrett Hall was constructed in 1994 and serves as student housing. The building was initially owned/operated by a private individual; however, in 2004 the Garrett County Commissioners purchased the building and leases to the college. Garrett College invested approximately \$50,000 of college funds to carpet and paint the interior which served as a useful refresh. This has increased the occupancy over the prior school year. This request is to reroof the building because the roof is at the end of its useful life. The building has 30 two bed rooms for a total occupancy of 60 residents. This request will allow the college to continue to house out-of-county students which the majority are Maryland residents.
