10. Description and Purpose of Organiza					

The Baltimore City Health Department serves as the Area Agency on Aging for advocacy, outreach and service delivery to older Baltimoreans, those with disabilities and caregivers. This includes services at 13 local senior centers (7 publically operated and 6 non-profits). Harford Road Senior Center is currently owned and operated by BCHD. The Harford site is located at 4920 Harford Road, in the Northeast Corridor of Baltimore City; 43rd Legislative District; Council District 3. It is the only senior center within the northeast east corridor.

11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit length to visible area)

Renovations to the Harford Road Senior Center includes major upgrades and construction to the approximately 7,400 square feet building located at 4290 Harford Road, including new roof, with solar panels, installation of a hard wired fire alarm system, new flooring, new windows, renovations of bathrooms to improve accessibility, raising of some ceilings in activities rooms and installation of proper insulation, installation of ADA compliant ramp, and other identified repairs not covered in the original life and safety modifications conducted in 2016. If needed, additional environmental abatement will be conducted along with said design and construction management cost of project. The building will be energy-efficient and meet Baltimore Citys green guidelines. Harford Road Senior Center will be owned by the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore City.
