The purpose of the Montgomery County Revenue Authority is to own and operate self sustaining projects to support education, economic development, human services, recreation and transportation needs through enterprises conducted within its authority as a public corporation. To accomplish its goals, the Authority engages in activities to construct, improve, equip, furnish and maintain projects devoted wholly or partially for the public good, use or general welfare; initiate public projects designed to stimulate employment or economic growth; develop and operate recreational facilities; assist in financing projects through the issuance of revenue bonds or other debt.

11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit length to visible area)

Utilization of excess land at the Poolesville Golf Course and development of a custom grape crush facility, new event facility, and 20+acres devoted to a vine incubator. The project will support education through partnerships with the University of Maryland, The Universities at Shady Grove and other educational institutions. It will develop new programs and support existing ones in agriculture, viticulture and enology science, hospitality, marketing and culinary arts. The goal is to provide residents throughout the State with job skills leading to employment. The project includes an area of land where entrepreneurs who are interested in the wine industry will be able to lease small parcels to start their businesses. This will significantly reduce the barriers to enter into the wine industry by lowering the cost of land and eliminating the cost of equipment.
