The Mary Harvin Transformation Center Community Development Corporation (CDC) was established in 2010 to serve as the economic and community development arm of Southern Baptist Church. The CDC offers programs, provides services, and engages in other activities that promote and support the Broadway East Community located in Baltimore, Maryland. Using its core value-restoring people as we rebuild properties and working it the community, other churches, and other partners (including Baltimore Housing, Humanim, Enterprise Community Partners, Woda Development, Johns Hopkins, Legg Mason, and others), the CDC has embarked on a multi-pronged neighborhood master plan to acquire an raze more than 100 properties in Broadway East and assemble them into developable sites for affordable housing,

retail, and community health amenities.

11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit length to visible area)

Mary Harvin recently released its master plan known as the East Baltimore Revitalization Plan which has been adopted by the City. Southern Streams is the next project in the plan. This \$31 million, 112,000 sq. ft. project, is anchored by Johns Hopkins Health Systems. This mixed-use project will provide needed community health services, dialysis, a pharmacy, a fitness center, financial literacy and job training, and early childhood/head start education and youth programming in a very distressed neighborhood. The project is funded by traditional debt, new markets tax credits, equity, and grants. The bond funds provide the requisite gap financing to enable it to proceed.
