Western Maryland Works is a planned makerspace and workforce training center established by Allegany County Government in partnership with Allegany College of Maryland. This 32,000+ square feet of space will allow individuals and businesses to utilize equipment to innovate, fabricate and design. The space will also be used to house Allegany College of Marylands advanced manufacturing and welding programs. Allegany County Government views the project as a much-needed economic development tool. First, it will incubate business creation by creating a space for entrepreneurs to grow new business ventures within our region. Second, it will be a space for businesses to provide additional training for their incumbent workers without the necessity of dedicating their own training space. Finally, it will be used as an attraction tool for businesses looking to expand in Allegany County as a mechanism to find and cultivate a pipeline of talent for their workforce needs.
