Harford County - Alcoholic Beverages - Continuing Care Facility for the Aged License

This bill specifies that the Harford County Board of License Commissioners may issue a Class CCFA (continuing care facility for the aged) beer, wine, and liquor (BWL) license to the *officers* of a continuing care facility. **The bill takes effect July 1, 2019.**

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None.

Local Effect: The bill is not anticipated to materially affect Harford County finances or operations.

Small Business Effect: Minimal.

Analysis

Current Law: The board may issue a Class CCFA BWL license *for the use* of a continuing care facility for the aged that meets specified criteria. The annual license fee is \$5,000.
