## AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 591

(First Reading File Bill)

#### AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 2, strike "Lost or Stolen"; in the same line, strike "Firearm – Reporting" and substitute "<u>Firearms – Penalties</u>"; strike beginning with "altering" in line 3 down through "change" in line 4 and substitute "<u>altering the penalty for knowingly participating in a straw purchase of a regulated firearm; altering the penalty for possessing, selling, transferring, or otherwise disposing of a stolen regulated firearm"; in lines 4 and 5, strike "reporting lost or stolen regulated firearms" and substitute "<u>straw purchases and possession of regulated firearms</u>"; in line 8, strike "5–146" and substitute "<u>5–138 and 5-141</u>"; and after line 10, insert:</u>

"BY repealing and reenacting, without amendments,

<u>Article - Public Safety</u>

Section 5-146

Annotated Code of Maryland

(2018 Replacement Volume and 2019 Supplement)".

## AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 1, after line 13, insert:

"<u>5–138.</u>

(A) A person may not possess, sell, transfer, or otherwise dispose of a stolen regulated firearm if the person knows or has reasonable cause to believe that the regulated firearm has been stolen.

- (B) (1) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A FELONY AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING 5 YEARS OR A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$10,000 OR BOTH.
  - (2) EACH VIOLATION OF THIS SECTION IS A SEPARATE CRIME.

#### 5–141.

- (a) A dealer or other person may not be a knowing participant in a straw purchase of a regulated firearm to a minor or to a person prohibited by law from possessing a regulated firearm.
- (b) A person who violates this section is guilty of a [misdemeanor] FELONY and on conviction is subject to imprisonment not exceeding 10 years or a fine not exceeding \$25,000 or both.
  - (c) Each violation of this section is a separate crime.".

On page 2, in lines 3, 5, 6, 7, 8, and 11, in each instance, strike the bracket; strike beginning with the colon in line 6 down through the comma in line 7; in lines 7 and 8, strike "6 MONTHS"; in line 8, strike "\$1,000"; and strike beginning with "; AND" in line 8 down through "BOTH" in line 10.
