AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 1121 (First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in the sponsor line, strike "and Valderrama" and substitute ", <u>Valderrama, Barron, Belcastro, Bhandari, Carr, Charles, Chisholm, Hill, Johnson, Kerr, Kipke, Krebs, R. Lewis, Morgan, Reilly, Rosenberg, Saab, Sample-Hughes, and <u>Szeliga</u>"; in line 6, after "requiring" insert ", <u>subject to the availability of funds</u>,"; in line 9, after "elements;" insert "<u>requiring the Department to determine the appropriate technology to support the operation of the Registry and Referral System and to consider certain factors when determining the appropriate technology;"; in line 11, after "Committee;" insert "<u>requiring the Advisory Committee to make certain recommendations to the Department;</u>"; strike beginning with "providing" in line 12 down through "System" in line 13 and substitute "<u>requiring the Department to adopt certain regulations</u>"; and in line 16, after "program," insert "<u>develop a certain plan</u>.".</u></u>

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, after line 11, insert:

"(D) "STATE-DESIGNATED HEALTH INFORMATION EXCHANGE" MEANS THE HEALTH INFORMATION EXCHANGE DESIGNATED BY THE MARYLAND HEALTH CARE COMMISSION UNDER § 19–143 OF THIS ARTICLE.";

and in line 19, strike "THE" and substitute "SUBJECT TO THE AVAILABILITY OF FUNDS, THE".

On page 3, after line 1, insert:

"(B) <u>THE DEPARTMENT SHALL:</u>

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(1) DETERMINE THE APPROPRIATE TECHNOLOGY TO SUPPORT THE OPERATION OF THE REGISTRY AND REFERRAL SYSTEM; AND

(2) TO THE EXTENT PRACTICABLE, CONSIDER EXISTING TECHNOLOGY OPERATED BY THE STATE-DESIGNATED HEALTH INFORMATION EXCHANGE, WORKFLOW OF PROVIDERS, AND PRACTICES OF PROVIDERS WHEN DETERMINING THE APPROPRIATE TECHNOLOGY FOR THE REGISTRY AND REFERRAL SYSTEM.";

in line 2, strike "(B)" and substitute "<u>(C)</u>"; strike beginning with "FROM" in line 14 down through "COMMISSION" in line 16 and substitute "<u>WITH EXPERTISE IN HEALTH</u> INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY, DESIGNATED BY THE MARYLAND CHAPTER OF THE <u>HEALTHCARE INFORMATION AND MANAGEMENT SYSTEMS SOCIETY</u>"; after line 21, insert:

"(4) THE ADVISORY COMMITTEE SHALL MAKE RECOMMENDATIONS TO THE DEPARTMENT RELATING TO THE DESIGN, DEVELOPMENT, IMPLEMENTATION, AND FUNDING OF THE REGISTRY AND REFERRAL SYSTEM ON:

(I) NECESSARY REGULATIONS;

(II) THE STATUS OF THE RESOURCE DIRECTORY AND PILOT PROGRAM DEVELOPED BY THE DEPARTMENT; AND

(III) SOURCES OF FUNDING, INCLUDING GRANT FUNDS AND OTHER SOURCES OF FEDERAL, PRIVATE, OR STATE FUNDS.";

in line 22, strike "(4)" and substitute "(5)"; and strike in their entirety lines 27 through 29, inclusive.

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On page 4, after line 4, insert:

"(E) <u>THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO CARRY OUT THIS</u> <u>SUBTITLE.</u>".

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 4, strike beginning with "that" in line 9 down through "public" in line 12; in line 16, strike "and"; after line 16, insert:

"(3) <u>develop a plan for funding the statewide expansion of the Maryland</u> <u>Mental Health and Substance Use Disorder Registry and Referral System established</u> <u>under § 7.5–802 of the Health – General Article, as enacted by Section 1 of this Act, and</u> <u>ongoing operations of the Registry and Referral System; and</u>";

in line 17, strike "(3)" and substitute "<u>(4)</u>"; in line 21, strike "and"; and in line 23, after "section" insert "<u>: and</u>

(iii) recommendations for enforcement mechanisms to be applied to providers who are mandated to use the Maryland Mental Health and Substance Use Disorder Registry and Referral System established under § 7.5–802 of the Health – General Article, as enacted by Section 1 of this Act".
