AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 6, after the semicolon insert "<u>requiring the establishment of a</u> <u>certain workgroup for a certain purpose before the installation of any vehicle height</u> <u>monitoring systems in Baltimore County; requiring the adoption of a certain local law</u> <u>before the installation of any vehicle height monitoring systems in Baltimore County;</u> <u>authorizing the adoption of a local law exempting certain vehicles from the enforcement</u> <u>of vehicle height restrictions by vehicle height monitoring systems in Baltimore</u> <u>County;</u>"; and in line 8, strike "the application of this Act" and substitute "<u>a delayed</u> <u>effective date</u>".

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 3, in line 17, after "(3)" insert "(I)"; and after line 17, insert:

"(II) IN BALTIMORE COUNTY, "OWNER" DOES NOT INCLUDE:

<u>1.</u> <u>A MOTOR VEHICLE RENTAL OR LEASING COMPANY;</u>

<u>OR</u>

2. <u>THE HOLDER OF AN INTERCHANGEABLE</u> REGISTRATION UNDER TITLE 13, SUBTITLE 9, PART III OF THIS ARTICLE.".

On page 8, after line 11, insert:

"(L) (1) THIS SUBSECTION APPLIES ONLY IN BALTIMORE COUNTY.

(2) <u>BEFORE THE INSTALLATION OF ANY VEHICLE HEIGHT</u> MONITORING SYSTEMS, THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE LOCAL JURISDICTION SHALL:

(I) ESTABLISH A WORKGROUP INCLUDING COMMERCIAL TRANSPORTATION INDUSTRY REPRESENTATIVES TO ASSIST THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT IN:

1. EVALUATING EXISTING TRUCK ROUTES;

2. <u>IDENTIFYING AREAS FOR VEHICLE HEIGHT</u> <u>MONITORING ENFORCEMENT; AND</u>

<u>3.</u> <u>EVALUATING EXISTING SIGNAGE AND</u> <u>IDENTIFYING LOCATIONS WHERE SIGNAGE COULD BE IMPROVED; AND</u>

(II) ADOPT A LOCAL LAW LIMITING THE OVERALL NUMBER OF VEHICLE HEIGHT MONITORING SYSTEMS THAT MAY BE PLACED IN THE LOCAL JURISDICTION.

(3) THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE LOCAL JURISDICTION MAY ADOPT A LOCAL LAW EXEMPTING CERTAIN VEHICLES FROM THE ENFORCEMENT OF HEIGHT RESTRICTIONS BY A VEHICLE HEIGHT MONITORING SYSTEM IN THE LOCAL JURISDICTION.";

and in line 13, strike "2020" and substitute "2021".

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 8, after line 11, insert:

"SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, before the installation of any vehicle height monitoring systems in Baltimore County, a workgroup established under § 24–111.3(l) of the Transportation Article, as enacted by Section 1 of this Act, shall examine and make recommendations to the Baltimore County Council on:

(1) <u>developing a map of height-restricted roads in the local jurisdiction</u> and providing the map to operators using the best available technology;

(2) <u>developing and implementing a process for a vehicle owner to easily</u> <u>contest an erroneously issued citation without the necessity of a court hearing;</u>

(3) <u>developing a process for the owner of a vehicle to identify and</u> <u>transfer liability to the operator of a vehicle responsible for incurring a citation; and</u>

(4) <u>exempting certain types of vehicles from enforcement by a vehicle</u> <u>height monitoring system.</u>";

and in line 12, strike "2." and substitute "3.".
