<u>AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 555</u> (Bill as Printed for Third Reading)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, strike line 2 in its entirety and substitute "<u>Election Administration – Absentee Ballot Canvass and Moratorium on Use of Wireless Network</u>"; in line 4, after "election;" insert "prohibiting the use of a wireless wide area network to transmit data from certain electronic poll books to the State Board of Elections or the local boards of elections during an election that is held before a certain date:"; and strike beginning with "the" in line 5 down through "ballots" in line 6 and substitute "<u>election administration</u>".

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, after line 7, insert:

"SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That a wireless wide area network or a Long Term Evolution cellular network may not be used to transmit data from the electronic poll books used in precinct polling places on Election Day to the State Board of Elections or the local boards of elections during an election that is held before January 1, 2021.";

and in line 8, strike "2." and substitute "3.".
