AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 1075 (First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 5, after "action;" insert "<u>authorizing any public school employee</u> who is subject to a certain personnel action to file an administrative complaint with a public school employer; requiring a public school employer to provide an administrative remedial process for a public school employee who files a certain administrative complaint; requiring a public school employer to complete a certain administrative remedial process within a certain number of days after a public school employee files an initial administrative complaint; requiring a public school employee who is subject to a certain personnel action, before instituting a civil action, to notify the local superintendent of schools in writing of the employee's intention to institute a civil action; altering the amount of time in which a public school employee is required to bring a certain action;".

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 3, strike beginning with the bracket in line 4 down through "section." in line 5 and substitute:

"(1) <u>Any public school employee who is subject to a</u> <u>personnel action in violation of § 6–902 of this subtitle may file an</u> <u>Administrative complaint with a public school employer.</u>

(2) <u>A PUBLIC SCHOOL EMPLOYER SHALL:</u>

(I) PROVIDE AN ADMINISTRATIVE REMEDIAL PROCESS FOR A PUBLIC SCHOOL EMPLOYEE WHO FILES AN ADMINISTRATIVE COMPLAINT UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION; AND

(II) <u>COMPLETE THE ADMINISTRATIVE REMEDIAL PROCESS</u> <u>UNDER ITEM (I) OF THIS PARAGRAPH WITHIN 30 DAYS AFTER A PUBLIC SCHOOL</u> <u>EMPLOYEE FILES AN INITIAL ADMINISTRATIVE COMPLAINT.</u>";

in line 6, strike the bracket; in the same line, strike "Any" and substitute:

"(1) BEFORE INSTITUTING A CIVIL ACTION, A PUBLIC SCHOOL EMPLOYEE WHO IS SUBJECT TO A PERSONNEL ACTION IN VIOLATION OF § 6–902 OF THIS SUBTITLE SHALL NOTIFY THE LOCAL SUPERINTENDENT IN WRITING OF THE EMPLOYEE'S INTENTION TO INSTITUTE A CIVIL ACTION.

(2) <u>SUBJECT TO PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION, ANY</u>";

in lines 8, 9, and 10, strike "(1)", "(2)", and "(3)", respectively, and substitute "(1)", "(11)", and "(111)", respectively; in line 11, strike "(B)" and substitute "(3)"; in the same line, strike "6" and substitute "<u>9</u>"; and in line 12, strike the second "6" and substitute "<u>9</u>".
