AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 7, after "regulations;" insert "<u>requiring the Maryland 529 Board</u> to submit a certain report to the General Assembly on the feasibility of establishing a certain separate plan for K–12 expenses on or before a certain date;".

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 3, after line 1, insert:

"SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That:

- (a) On or before December 1, 2020, the Maryland 529 Board shall submit a report to the General Assembly, in accordance with § 2-1257 of the State Government Article, on the feasibility of establishing a separate plan for 529 accounts that are used to pay for K–12 expenses in accordance with federal tax laws arising from the Tax Cuts and Jobs Act of 2017.
 - (b) The report in paragraph (a) of this section shall include:
 - (1) <u>a structure for a separate K-12 plan;</u>
 - (2) estimated costs for the plan;
- (3) the number and types of plans an account holder may open for an individual beneficiary; and
- (4) the income tax subtractions and contribution benefits for each type of plan.";
