"(2) (I) <u>AN INDIVIDUAL WHO, AS OF JANUARY 1, 2020, HOLDS A</u> <u>LICENSE, REGISTRATION, OR CERTIFICATION TO PERFORM ON-SITE</u> <u>WASTEWATER SERVICES IN THE STATE MAY CONTINUE TO PERFORM ON-SITE</u> <u>WASTEWATER SERVICES UNTIL THE LICENSING REQUIREMENTS ARE</u> <u>ESTABLISHED BY THE DEPARTMENT BY REGULATION IF THE INDIVIDUAL:</u>

1.ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 31, 2020, PAYS TO THEDEPARTMENT A FEE OF \$150; AND

<u>2.</u> <u>EVERY 2 YEARS THEREAFTER UNTIL THE</u> <u>DEPARTMENT SETS FEES IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 9–11A–10 OF THIS SUBTITLE,</u> <u>PAYS TO THE DEPARTMENT A RENEWAL FEE OF \$150.</u>

(II) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL PAY ALL FUNDS COLLECTED UNDER PARAGRAPH (2)(I) OF THIS SUBSECTION INTO THE ON-SITE WASTEWATER PROFESSIONALS FUND ESTABLISHED UNDER § 9–11A–11 OF THIS SUBTITLE.";

in line 5, after "ESTABLISHED" insert "<u>BY THE DEPARTMENT</u>"; in line 10, strike "**BOARD**" and substitute "**DEPARTMENT BY REGULATION**"; after line 14, insert:

"(E) <u>A LICENSE ISSUED BY THE BOARD IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS</u> SUBTITLE IS VALID FOR 2 YEARS.";

AMENDMENT NO. 4

On page 15, after line 4, insert:

"<u>SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED</u>, That, on or before July 1, 2023, the Department of the Environment, in consultation with the State Board of On–Site Wastewater Professionals, shall adopt regulations to implement Section 1 of this Act.
