AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in the sponsor line, strike "and Terrasa" and substitute "<u>Terrasa</u>, <u>Barron</u>, <u>Bhandari</u>, <u>Charles</u>, <u>Chisholm</u>, <u>Cullison</u>, <u>Hill</u>, <u>Johnson</u>, <u>Kelly</u>, <u>Kerr</u>, <u>Morgan</u>, <u>Pena–Melnyk</u>, <u>Pendergrass</u>, <u>Reilly</u>, <u>Rosenberg</u>, <u>Sample–Hughes</u>, and <u>Szeliga</u>"; after line 3, insert:

"(The Christopher King Access to Treatment Act)";

and in line 18, after "definition;" insert "defining a certain term;".

On page 2, after line 3, insert:

"BY adding to

Article - Health Occupations

Section 12-101(o-1)

Annotated Code of Maryland

(2014 Replacement Volume and 2019 Supplement)".

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, after line 30, insert:

"(O-1) (1) "MAINTENANCE INJECTABLE MEDICATION" MEANS A MEDICATION THAT:

(I) IS ADMINISTERED BY INJECTION OTHER THAN INTRAVENOUSLY; AND

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- (II) TREATS A CHRONIC NEED, CONDITION, OR DISORDER.
- (2) "MAINTENANCE INJECTABLE MEDICATION" INCLUDES A MEDICATION FOR THE TREATMENT OF A PSYCHIATRIC DISORDER OR SUBSTANCE USE DISORDER, CONTRACEPTION, VITAMINS, AND ANY OTHER CLASS OF MEDICATION APPROVED UNDER § 12–509(B)(II) OF THIS TITLE.".

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 3, strike line 9 in its entirety and substitute:

- "(I) 1. IF THE MAINTENANCE INJECTABLE MEDICATION
 IS PRESCRIBED BY AN AUTHORIZED PRESCRIBER; AND
- 2. If the authorized prescriber has not ordered that the initial dose of the maintenance injectable medication be administered by a prescriber;":

in line 16, strike "ESTABLISHING STANDARD PROCEDURES"; after line 16, insert:

"(I) ESTABLISHING STANDARD PROCEDURES:";

in lines 17 and 20, strike "(I)" and "(II)", respectively, and substitute "<u>1.</u>" and "<u>2.</u>", respectively; and in line 22, after "CONDITION" insert "<u>; AND</u>

(II) APPROVING CLASSES OF MAINTENANCE INJECTABLE MEDICATIONS THAT MAY BE ADMINISTERED UNDER SUBSECTION (A)(2) OF THIS SECTION".
