AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, after line 20, insert:

"(3) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL DEVELOP AND PUBLISH ON ITS WEBSITE FOR USE BY THE PUBLIC A SEARCHABLE MAP OF ZONES OF DEWATERING INFLUENCE ESTABLISHED BY THE DEPARTMENT UNDER THIS SUBSECTION.".

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 4, in line 20, strike "A ZONE OF DEWATERING INFLUENCE" and substitute "BALTIMORE COUNTY, CARROLL COUNTY, FREDERICK COUNTY, AND WASHINGTON COUNTY".

On pages 4 and 5, strike beginning with "VENDOR" in line 21 on page 4 down through "REGULATIONS" in line 9 on page 5 and substitute "CONTRACT FOR THE SALE OF REAL PROPERTY SHALL INCLUDE, IN CONSPICUOUS, BOLD, AND UNDERSCORED TYPE, THE FOLLOWING BUYER NOTICE IN THE CONTRACT:

"NOTICE ON ZONES OF DEWATERING INFLUENCE"

WHETHER THE REAL PROPERTY FOR PURCHASE IS LOCATED WITHIN A ZONE OF DEWATERING INFLUENCE. MARYLAND LAW PROVIDES CERTAIN REMEDIES FOR PROPERTY IMPACTED BY DEWATERING".

On page 5 in lines 10, 15, and 21, in each instance, strike "**DOCUMENTS**" and substitute "**NOTICE**"; in line 15, after "(2)" insert "(I)"; in lines 19 and 22, strike "(I)" and "(II)", respectively, and substitute "1." and "2.", respectively; after line 23, insert:

"(II) THE RETURN OF ANY DEPOSITS HELD IN TRUST BY A LICENSED REAL ESTATE BROKER TO A PURCHASER UNDER SUBPARAGRAPH (I)1 OF THIS PARAGRAPH SHALL COMPLY WITH THE PROCEDURES SET FORTH IN § 17–505 OF THE BUSINESS OCCUPATIONS AND PROFESSIONS ARTICLE.";

and strike in their entirety lines 24 through 29, inclusive, and substitute:

"14–117.

- (e) A contract of sale shall also comply with the following provisions, if applicable:
- (21) Section 13–504 of the Tax Property Article (notice of liability for agricultural land transfer tax in Washington County); [and]
- (22) Section 6-824 of the Environment Article (disclosure pertaining to obligations to perform risk reduction); AND
- (23) SECTION 10-711 OF THIS ARTICLE (NOTICE ON ZONES OF DEWATERING INFLUENCE).".
