AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 2, strike "Assessment" and substitute "<u>Scoring</u>"; in line 3, strike "aid" and substitute "<u>assist</u>"; in line 6, after "period;" insert "<u>making an independent</u> validation study conducted in accordance with this Act for a certain instrument used in a certain pretrial services program eligible for certain grant funding;"; in the same line, strike "a"; in the same line, strike "term" and substitute "<u>terms</u>; providing for a delayed <u>effective date</u>"; and after line 12, insert:

"BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

<u>Article - Public Safety</u> <u>Section 4-1101, 4-1102(b), 4-1103(b), and 4-1104</u> <u>Annotated Code of Maryland</u> (2018 Replacement Volume and 2019 Supplement)

<u>BY repealing and reenacting, without amendments,</u> <u>Article - Public Safety</u> <u>Section 4-1102(a)</u> <u>Annotated Code of Maryland</u> <u>(2018 Replacement Volume and 2019 Supplement)</u>".

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 1, in lines 17 and 21, in each instance, strike "ASSESSMENT" and substitute "<u>SCORING</u>"; and in line 18, strike "DETERMINE" and substitute "<u>ASSIST IN</u> <u>DETERMINING</u>".

On page 2, in line 1, strike "ASSESSMENT" and substitute "<u>SCORING</u>"; in the same line, strike "**3**" and substitute "<u>5</u>"; after line 1, insert:

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"Article – Public Safety

4-1101.

(a) In this subtitle the following words have the meanings indicated.

- (b) <u>"Eligible county" means:</u>
 - (1) <u>a county that does not provide defendants with pretrial services; or</u>

(2) <u>a county that does provide defendants with pretrial services, but</u> seeks to improve the pretrial services to comply with § 4–1104 of this subtitle.

(c) <u>"Executive Director" means the Executive Director of the Governor's Office</u> of Crime Control and Prevention.

(d) <u>"Fund" means the Pretrial Services Program Grant Fund.</u>

(e) <u>"PRETRIAL RISK SCORING INSTRUMENT VALIDATION" MEANS AN</u> INDEPENDENT VALIDATION STUDY OF A PRETRIAL RISK SCORING TOOL UNDER § 5–103 OF THE CRIMINAL PROCEDURE ARTICLE.

(F) <u>"Pretrial services program" means a program established in accordance</u> with § 4–1104 of this subtitle.

4-1102.

(a) <u>There is a Pretrial Services Program Grant Fund.</u>

(b) The purpose of the Fund is to provide grants to eligible counties to:

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(1) establish pretrial services programs; [or]

(2) improve existing pretrial services programs to comply with § 4–1104 of this subtitle; OR

(3) <u>CONDUCT PRETRIAL RISK SCORING INSTRUMENT</u> VALIDATIONS IN COMPLIANCE WITH § 5–103 OF THE CRIMINAL PROCEDURE <u>ARTICLE.</u>

4-1103.

(b) <u>An eligible county that applies for a grant from the Fund shall provide the</u> <u>Executive Director with:</u>

(1) <u>a description of how:</u>

(I) the proposed pretrial services program or proposed pretrial services program improvements will meet the requirements of § 4–1104 of this subtitle; OR

(II) THE PRETRIAL SERVICES PROGRAM FOR WHICH THE PRETRIAL RISK SCORING INSTRUMENT VALIDATION IS PROPOSED MEETS THE REQUIREMENTS OF § 4–1104 OF THIS SUBTITLE; and

(2) any other information that the Executive Director considers necessary.

4-1104.

(Over)

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<u>A pretrial services program established</u> [or], improved, OR FOR WHICH A <u>PRETRIAL RISK SCORING INSTRUMENT VALIDATION IS CONDUCTED</u> using a grant distributed in accordance with § 4–1103 of this subtitle shall:

(1) use a validated, evidence-based, race-neutral risk scoring instrument that is consistent with the Maryland Rules to make recommendations to a judicial officer to determine whether a defendant:

- (i) is eligible for release:
 - <u>1.</u> <u>on personal recognizance; or</u>
 - <u>2.</u> with appropriate pretrial supervision; or
- (ii) should be held without bail;
- (2) apply best practices shown to be effective in other jurisdictions; and

(3) incorporate multiple levels of supervision based on defendant risk scores with features that include:

- (i) <u>cellular telephone reminders of a defendant's hearing date;</u>
- (ii) drug and alcohol testing;
- (iii) global positioning satellite monitoring, if applicable; and

(iv) <u>substance abuse, mental health, or mediation referrals, if</u> <u>approved by the judicial officer and available in the eligible county.</u>";

and in line 3, strike "October 1, 2020" and substitute "July 1, 2021".
