BY repealing and reenacting, without amendments, Article – Alcoholic Beverages Section 19–102 Annotated Code of Maryland (2016 Volume and 2019 Supplement) BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments, Article – Alcoholic Beverages Section 19-903 Annotated Code of Maryland (2016 Volume and 2019 Supplement) SECTION 1.
