- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 16 Article Education
- 17 5–101.

18 (G) (1) IN ADDITION TO ALL OTHER CATEGORIES REQUIRED BY 19 SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, THE ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY BOARD OF 20 EDUCATION ANNUAL BUDGET SHALL INCLUDE AN EQUITY CATEGORY.

(2) THE EQUITY CATEGORY SHALL INCLUDE FUNDING FOR EXISTING AND PROPOSED EQUITY INTERVENTIONS IN THE ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY PUBLIC SCHOOL SYSTEM SEPARATED INTO THREE SUBCATEGORIES, INCLUDING:

 INTERVENTIONS IN THE ANNUAL BUDGET ARE BEING INCREASED, MAINTAINED, OR
 REDUCED FROM THE PRIOR ANNUAL BUDGET FOR EACH SUBCATEGORY.

4 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 5 1, 2020.
