1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Baltimore County – Career Exploration and Development Activities in Public**
3 **High Schools – Coffee**

4 FOR the purpose of prohibiting an Executive Branch agency from banning or regulating
5 the sale of coffee in conjunction with a career exploration and development activity
6 in any public high school in Baltimore County, if the activity is directed at or
7 organized by students with individualized education programs; repealing a certain
8 exception that prohibited banning or regulating the sale of coffee in a Baltimore
9 County public high school that sold coffee on or before a certain date in conjunction
10 with a certain activity; and generally relating to the sale of coffee in conjunction with
11 a career exploration and development activity in a public high school in Baltimore
12 County.

18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
19 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

20 **Article – Education**

1 (a) This section applies only in Baltimore County.

2 (b) [Except as provided in subsection (c) of this section, an] AN Executive Branch
3 agency may NOT ban or regulate the sale of coffee in conjunction with a career exploration
4 and development activity in a public high school, **IF THE ACTIVITY IS DIRECTED AT OR**
5 **ORGANIZED BY STUDENTS WITH INDIVIDUALIZED EDUCATION PROGRAMS.**

6 [(c) An Executive Branch agency may not ban or regulate the sale of coffee in
7 conjunction with a career exploration and development activity in a public high school that
8 sold coffee on or before June 30, 2018.]

9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
10 1, 2020.
