Vehicle Emissions Inspection Program – Deployed Military Personnel – Exemption

- FOR the purpose of exempting certain active duty members of the armed services of the

 vehicle emissions inspections; requiring all owners of a motor vehicle for which an
 exemption is sought under this Act to certify in a certain manner that a certain
 individual is subject to certain deployment; and generally relating to exemptions
 from the vehicle emissions inspection program.

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, 16 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 19 (a) (1) A motor vehicle for which special registration plates have been issued

122.TO A DUTY STATION IN A JURISDICTION THAT IS NOT13SUBJECT TO A VEHICLE EMISSIONS CONTROL INSPECTION AND MAINTENANCE14PROGRAM; AND

15(II) THE EXEMPTION IS NOT OTHERWISE PROHIBITED BY16FEDERAL LAW.
