## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **General Provisions – State Song – Advisory Panel**

3 FOR the purpose of repealing the State song; establishing the State Song Advisory Panel;  
4 providing for the composition, chair, and staffing of the Advisory Panel; prohibiting  
5 a member of the Advisory Panel from receiving certain compensation, but  
6 authorizing the reimbursement of certain expenses; requiring the Advisory Panel to  
7 review certain submissions and suggestions; requiring the Advisory Panel to conduct  
8 certain public hearings; requiring the Advisory Panel to report certain  
9 recommendations to the Governor and the General Assembly on or before a certain  
10 date; providing for a delayed effective date for a certain provision of this Act;  
11 providing for the termination of a certain provision of this Act; and generally relating  
12 to the State song.

18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,  
19 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

20 **Article – General Provisions**

21 [7–318.

22 (a) The poem “Maryland! My Maryland!”, written by James Ryder Randall in  
23 1861 and set to the tune of “Lauriger Horatius”, is the State song.

41                  SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That:

1 (a) There is a State Song Advisory Panel.

2 (b) The Advisory Panel consists of the following members:

3 (1) two members of the Senate of Maryland, appointed by the President of  
4 the Senate;

5 (2) two members of the House of Delegates, appointed by the Speaker of  
6 the House;

7 (3) the State Archivist, or the State Archivist's designee;

8 (4) the President of the Maryland Historical Society, or the President's  
9 designee; and

10 (5) five residents of the State, appointed by the Governor.

11 (c) The Governor shall designate the chair of the Advisory Panel.

12 (d) The State Archives shall provide staff for the Advisory Panel.

13 (e) A member of the Advisory Panel:

14 (1) may not receive compensation as a member of the Advisory Panel; but

15 (2) is entitled to reimbursement for expenses under the Standard State  
16 Travel Regulations, as provided in the State budget.

17 (f) The Advisory Panel shall:

18 (1) review public submissions and suggestions for a new State song;

19 (2) hold at least three public hearings to receive input and  
20 recommendations from the public regarding an appropriate State song; and

21 (3) recommend lyrics and a melody based on the public submissions,  
22 suggestions, input, and recommendations received under this Act for the General Assembly  
23 to consider adopting as the State song.

24 (g) On or before December 1, 2020, the Advisory Panel shall report its  
25 recommendations to the Governor and, in accordance with § 2-1257 of the State  
26 Government Article, the General Assembly.

27 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Section 1 of this Act shall take  
28 effect June 1, 2021.

29 SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, except as provided in Section

1 3 of this Act, this Act shall take effect June 1, 2020. Section 2 of this Act shall remain  
2 effective for a period of 1 year and 1 month and, at the end of June 30, 2021, Section 2 of  
3 this Act, with no further action required by the General Assembly, shall be abrogated and  
4 of no further force and effect.
