- 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 14 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 17 **(A)** If the official custodian has adopted rules or regulations that define, **SUBJECT**18 **TO SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION,** "sociological information" for purposes of this
 19 section, a custodian shall deny inspection of the part of a public record that contains
 20 sociological information, in accordance with the rules or regulations.
- 21 (B) A DEFINITION OF "SOCIOLOGICAL INFORMATION" ADOPTED UNDER 22 SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION MAY NOT INCLUDE AN INDIVIDUAL'S PERSONAL 23 ADDRESS.
