A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Behavioral Health Administration – Children With Mental Disorders – List of**
3 **Available Services**

4 FOR the purpose of requiring the Behavioral Health Administration to maintain a certain
5 list of the specific services in certain service categories that are available to a child
6 in the State who has a mental disorder; requiring that the list include services
7 available to any child in the State who has a mental disorder and who is enrolled in
8 the Maryland Medical Assistance Program or has health insurance coverage;
9 requiring the Administration to establish a certain method by which a person may
10 request the list and make the list available to a person on request; and generally
11 relating to a list of services available to children with mental disorders.

14 Section 10–908 to be under the new part “Part II. Services Available to Children

18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
19 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

20 **Article – Health – General**

21 **PART II. SERVICES AVAILABLE TO CHILDREN WITH MENTAL DISORDERS.**

22 **10–908.**

23 **(A) THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL MAINTAIN AN UPDATED LIST OF THE**
24 **SPECIFIC SERVICES IN EACH OF THE FOLLOWING SERVICE CATEGORIES THAT ARE**

EXPLANATION: CAPITALS INDICATE MATTER ADDED TO EXISTING LAW.
[Brackets] indicate matter deleted from existing law.



1 AVAILABLE TO A CHILD IN THE STATE WHO HAS A MENTAL DISORDER:

2 (1) PSYCHIATRIC REHABILITATION SERVICES;

3 (2) THERAPEUTIC SERVICES;

4 (3) CARE COORDINATION SERVICES; AND

5 (4) HOME HEALTH AIDE SERVICES.

6 (B) THE LIST MAINTAINED UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION SHALL
7 INCLUDE SERVICES AVAILABLE TO ANY CHILD IN THE STATE WHO HAS A MENTAL
8 DISORDER AND WHO IS ENROLLED IN THE MARYLAND MEDICAL ASSISTANCE
9 PROGRAM OR HAS HEALTH INSURANCE COVERAGE.

10 (C) THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL:

11 (1) ESTABLISH A METHOD BY WHICH A PERSON MAY REQUEST THE
12 LIST MAINTAINED IN SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION THROUGH THE
13 ADMINISTRATION'S WEBSITE; AND

14 (2) MAKE THE LIST MAINTAINED UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS
15 SECTION AVAILABLE TO A PERSON ON REQUEST, EITHER THROUGH THE METHOD
16 ESTABLISHED IN ITEM (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION OR THROUGH ANY OTHER MEANS.

17 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
18 October 1, 2020.
