- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
  That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 (A) ANY STATE AID PROVIDED UNDER THE JOSEPH A. SELLINGER 18 PROGRAM TO A PRIVATE NONPROFIT INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION 19 LOCATED IN FREDERICK COUNTY MAY BE USED ONLY TO PROVIDE FINANCIAL AID 20 AWARDS TO STUDENTS ATTENDING THE INSTITUTION WHO GRADUATED FROM A 21 HIGH SCHOOL LOCATED IN THE STATE.

(B) IN AWARDING FINANCIAL AID IN ACCORDANCE WITH SUBSECTION (A) OF
 THIS SECTION, A PRIVATE NONPROFIT INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION
 LOCATED IN FREDERICK COUNTY SHALL GIVE PRIORITY TO STUDENTS WHO



## 1 GRADUATED FROM A HIGH SCHOOL LOCATED IN FREDERICK COUNTY.

2 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 3 1, 2020.
