BY adding to Article – Education Section 7–433.1 Annotated Code of Maryland (2018 Replacement Volume and 2019 Supplement) BY adding to Article – Health – General Section 14–502 Annotated Code of Maryland (2019 Replacement Volume) SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
