4 FOR the purpose of establishing the Private Sector Transportation Projects Ombudsman within the Department of Transportation; requiring the Secretary of Transportation 5 6 to designate an individual to serve as Ombudsman; requiring the Ombudsman to 7 respond to concerns, complaints, and other inquiries from certain entities regarding 8 certain private sector transportation projects; providing that the Ombudsman is an 9 employee of the Department; requiring the Department to provide the Ombudsman 10 with sufficient resources to respond to all inquiries in an accurate and timely 11 manner; requiring the Department to include the name and contact information of 12 the Ombudsman on the Department's website and in a certain document; and 13 generally relating to the designation of a Private Sector Transportation Projects Ombudsman. 14
