- FOR the purpose of requiring each accessible room in a lodging establishment to be furnished with a bed of a certain height on or before a certain date, beginning on a certain date; requiring at least certain percentages of accessible rooms in a lodging establishment to be furnished with a bed of a certain height, beginning on certain dates; defining a certain term; and generally relating to lodging establishments.

- 4 (c) "Lodging establishment" means an inn, hotel, motel, or other establishment 5 that has at least four rooms available for a fee to transient guests for lodging or sleeping 6 purposes.

- 8 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "ACCESSIBLE ROOM" MEANS A ROOM IN A LODGING 9 ESTABLISHMENT THAT IS REQUIRED TO BE IN COMPLIANCE WITH THE TRANSIENT 10 LODGING REQUIREMENTS OF THE AMERICANS WITH DISABILITIES ACT.
- 11 (B) ON OR BEFORE APRIL 1, 2021 SUBJECT TO SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS
 12 SECTION, EACH ACCESSIBLE ROOM IN A LODGING ESTABLISHMENT SHALL BE
 13 FURNISHED WITH A BED THAT:
- 14 (1) MEASURES AT LEAST 20 INCHES BUT NOT MORE THAN 23 INCHES
 15 HIGH FROM THE FLOOR TO THE TOP OF THE MATTRESS, WHETHER OR NOT THE
 16 MATTRESS IS COMPRESSED; AND
- 17 (2) HAS AT LEAST A 7-INCH VERTICAL CLEARANCE UNDER THE BED 18 FOR LIFT ACCESS.
- 19 (C) **(1) BEGINNING DECEMBER** 31, 2021, **EACH** LODGING 20 ESTABLISHMENT SHALL FURNISH AT LEAST 25% \mathbf{OF} THE LODGING 21ESTABLISHMENT'S ACCESSIBLE ROOMS WITH A BED THAT MEETS THE 22REQUIREMENTS OF SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION.
- 23 **(2) BEGINNING DECEMBER** 31, 2022, **EACH** LODGING 24ESTABLISHMENT SHALL FURNISH AT LEAST 50% \mathbf{OF} THE **LODGING** 25ESTABLISHMENT'S ACCESSIBLE ROOMS WITH A BED THAT MEETS THE REQUIREMENTS OF SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION. 26
- 27**BEGINNING** DECEMBER **(3)** 31, 2023, **EACH LODGING** ESTABLISHMENT SHALL FURNISH AT LEAST 75% 28OF THE LODGING 29 ESTABLISHMENT'S ACCESSIBLE ROOMS WITH A BED THAT MEETS THE 30 REQUIREMENTS OF SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION.

(4) BEGINNING DECEMBER 31, 2024, EACH ACCESSIBLE ROOM IN A
LODGING ESTABLISHMENT SHALL BE FURNISHED WITH A BED THAT MEETS THE
REQUIREMENTS OF SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION.
SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2020.
