- 19 (3) the following entities, selected jointly by the Secretary of Housing and 20 Community Development and the Secretary of Human Services:
- 21 (i) participating banks;
- 22 (ii) participating realtors, selected by the Secretary of Housing and 23 Community Development and the Secretary of Human Services jointly;

It shall remain effective for a period of 1 year and 1 month and, at the end of June 30, 2021, this Act, with no further action required by the General Assembly, shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.
