BY adding to Article – Labor and Employment Section 11–605 Annotated Code of Maryland (2016 Replacement Volume and 2019 Supplement) SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: **Article - Labor and Employment** 11-605.THE DEPARTMENT SHALL DEVELOP A LIST OF ANY FEDERAL OR STATE (A) INCENTIVE PROGRAMS AVAILABLE TO AN EMPLOYER WHO HIRES AND TRAINS FORMERLY INCARCERATED INDIVIDUALS.
