- 1 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 2 Article - Alcoholic Beverages 10-102.3 This title applies only in the City of Annapolis. 4 10-1104. 5 6 (A) THERE IS A CLUB PUBLIC EVENT PERMIT. 7 (B) THE BOARD MAY ISSUE THE PERMIT TO A HOLDER OF A CLASS C 8 LICENSE. 9 (C) SUBJECT TO SUBSECTION (D) OF THIS SECTION, THE PERMIT 10 AUTHORIZES A CLUB TO SELL ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES THAT ARE ALLOWED UNDER 11 THE CLUB'S CLASS C LICENSE: 12 **(1)** DURING A PUBLIC EVENT SPONSORED BY THE CLUB AT THE PLACE 13 DESCRIBED IN THE LICENSE; 14 **(2)** TO AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS NOT A MEMBER OF THE CLUB OR A 15 **GUEST OF A MEMBER; AND** 16 **(3)** FOR ON-PREMISES CONSUMPTION.
