- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

16 ON ACCEPTANCE FOR ADMISSION, EACH CONSTITUENT INSTITUTION SHALL 17 NOTIFY THE ACCEPTED STUDENT OF A REASONABLE ESTIMATE OF THE INCOME THE 18 STUDENT MAY RECEIVE AFTER COMPLETING EACH DEGREE OFFERED BY THE 19 CONSTITUENT INSTITUTION.

20 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 21 1, 2020.
