2 **Barbers – Employment of Apprentice Barbers – Alterations**

3 FOR the purpose of increasing the maximum number of apprentice barbers per master
4 barber that a barber shop may employ at the same time; repealing a limit on the
5 total number of apprentice barbers that a barbershop may employ at the same time;
6 and generally relating to the employment and supervision of apprentice barbers.

17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
18 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

19 **Article – Business Occupations and Professions**

20 4–507.

1 (a) A barbershop may not employ at the same time more than[:

2 (1) 1] 3 apprentice [barber] BARBERS for each master barber employed[;
3 and

4 (2) a total of 3 apprentice barbers].

5 (d) (1) An apprentice barber under complete and constant supervision of a
6 master barber may assist the master barber in starting or completing an operation. The
7 master barber or barbershop may charge the usual fees for the operation.

8 (2) A fee may not be charged for an operation performed completely by an
9 apprentice barber.

10 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
11 October 1, 2020.
