CHAPTER _____

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Washington County – Mobile Home Tax – Authorization

3 FOR the purpose of providing that Washington County may not impose a certain tax on the
4 amounts paid for certain purposes to a mobile home park; authorizing Washington
5 County to impose, by ordinance, a tax on the use of a mobile home in the county;
6 providing for the application, manner of calculation, payment, and collection of the
7 tax; providing that the tax constitutes a lien on the mobile home and may be collected
8 in a certain manner; requiring the Director of the State Department of Assessments
9 and Taxation to direct the Department to assess the value of certain mobile homes
10 in Washington County under certain circumstances; authorizing Washington County
11 to provide, by ordinance, for certain matters related to the tax; defining a certain
12 term; and generally relating to a mobile home tax in Washington County.

16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
17 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18 **Article – Local Government**

19 20–501.

20 (a) (1) In this section the following words have the meanings indicated.

21 (2) “Camping shelter” means a tent or other collapsible structure that
22 provides temporary living quarters for recreational, camping, or travel use.

23 (3) “Mobile home park” means a mobile home court or park or a trailer
24 park.

25 (4) “Recreational vehicle” means a trailer or other vehicle that provides
26 temporary living quarters for recreational, camping, or travel use.

27 (b) **(1) THIS SUBSECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO A MOBILE HOME IN**
28 **WASHINGTON COUNTY.**

29 **[(1)] (2)** By resolution or ordinance, a county or municipality may impose
30 a tax on the amount paid for:

31 (i) the rental, leasing, or use of any space, facility, or
32 accommodation in a mobile home park; or

33 (ii) services provided by a mobile home park.

1 **[(2)] (3)** The tax authorized under this subsection does not apply to a
2 recreational vehicle or camping shelter if:

3 (i) the recreational vehicle or camping shelter is intended and used
4 only for temporary occupancy of 30 days or less; or

5 (ii) the county or municipality imposes the tax authorized under
6 subsection (c) of this section.

7 **20-503.**

8 **(A) IN THIS SECTION, “MOBILE HOME” MEANS A FORM OF HOUSING THAT:**

9 **(1) IS COMMONLY KNOWN AS A TRAILER, HOUSE TRAILER, OR**
10 **MANUFACTURED HOME;**

11 **(2) IS OR CAN BE USED FOR RESIDENTIAL PURPOSES; AND**

12 **(3) (I) IS PERMANENTLY ATTACHED TO LAND; OR**

13 **(II) IS CONNECTED TO WATER, GAS, ELECTRIC, OR SEWAGE**
14 **FACILITIES.**

15 **(B) BY ORDINANCE, WASHINGTON COUNTY MAY IMPOSE A TAX ON THE USE**
16 **OF A MOBILE HOME LOCATED IN THE COUNTY.**

17 **(C) THE TAX AUTHORIZED UNDER THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO A**
18 **MOBILE HOME THAT IS HELD FOR SALE ON A SALES LOT.**

19 **(D) THE TAX AUTHORIZED UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL BE APPLIED ON THE**
20 **ASSESSED VALUE OF THE MOBILE HOME.**

21 **(E) (1) AN OWNER OF PROPERTY ON WHICH A MOBILE HOME SUBJECT TO**
22 **THE TAX UNDER THIS SECTION IS LOCATED SHALL PAY THE TAX TO THE COUNTY**
23 **OFFICE THAT THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WASHINGTON COUNTY DESIGNATE**
24 **BY ORDINANCE.**

25 **(2) (I) IF THE OCCUPANT OF A MOBILE HOME SUBJECT TO THE TAX**
26 **UNDER THIS SECTION RENTS FROM THE PROPERTY OWNER THE MOBILE HOME OR**
27 **THE PROPERTY ON WHICH THE MOBILE HOME IS LOCATED, THE PROPERTY OWNER**
28 **MAY COLLECT THE TAX FROM THE OCCUPANT OF THE MOBILE HOME.**

29 **(II) THE PROPERTY OWNER MAY COLLECT THE TAX FROM THE**
30 **OCCUPANT UNDER SUBPARAGRAPH (I) OF THIS PARAGRAPH AS A PART OF THE**

1 RENTAL FEES.

7 (F) IF THE COUNTY IMPOSES THE TAX AUTHORIZED UNDER THIS SECTION,
8 THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF ASSESSMENTS AND TAXATION SHALL ASSESS THE
9 VALUE OF MOBILE HOMES IN WASHINGTON COUNTY SUBJECT TO THE TAX.

10 (G) A TAX IMPOSED UNDER THIS SECTION CONSTITUTES A LIEN ON THE
11 MOBILE HOME AND MAY BE COLLECTED IN THE SAME MANNER AS PROPERTY TAXES
12 MAY BE COLLECTED.

13 (H) IF THE COUNTY IMPOSES THE TAX AUTHORIZED UNDER THIS SECTION,
14 THE COUNTY, BY ORDINANCE, MAY PROVIDE FOR:

17 (2) MAINTENANCE OF RECORDS RELATING TO THE TAX AND ITS
18 COLLECTION;

19 (3) OTHER REQUIREMENTS RELATING TO THE ADMINISTRATION OF
20 THE TAX; AND

26 (j) (1) "Department" means the State Department of Assessments and
27 Taxation.

(2) "Department" includes, unless the context requires otherwise, a supervisor.

1 **IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 20-503 OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, THE**
2 **DIRECTOR SHALL DIRECT THAT THE DEPARTMENT ASSESS THE VALUE OF MOBILE**
3 **HOMES IN WASHINGTON COUNTY SUBJECT TO THE TAX IMPOSED UNDER THAT**
4 **SECTION.**

5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July
6 1, 2020.
