- 3 DURING SERVICES AND GATHERINGS, AND WHO HAS THE INTENT TO CARRY, WEAR,
- 4 OR TRANSPORT A HANDGUN FOR PURPOSES RELATED TO SELF-PROTECTION OR THE
- 5 PROTECTION OF OTHERS WHILE ON THE PROPERTY OF THE CHURCH MAY, WITHOUT
- 6 A PERMIT, WITH ADVANCE NOTICE TO THE PRIMARY LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY OF
