19 ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 1 EACH YEAR, EACH EMPLOYER SHALL REPORT TO 20 THE MARYLAND DEPARTMENT OF LABOR AND THE MARYLAND HIGHER 21 EDUCATION COMMISSION AND MAKE AVAILABLE TO THE PUBLIC THE NUMBER OF 22 THE EMPLOYER'S EMPLOYEES WHO HAVE BEEN GRANTED AN H–1B OR L–1 VISA BY 23 THE U.S. CITIZENSHIP AND IMMIGRATION SERVICES.
