1 AN ACT concerning

Residential Construction - Electric Vehicle Charging

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the construction of certain new housing units a builder of 4 certain new housing units or a builder's agent to provide each buyer or prospective 5 buyer with the option to include on or in a certain garage, carport, or driveway a certain electric vehicle charging station or a dedicated electric line with certain 6 7 voltage under certain circumstances; requiring the construction of certain housing 8 units that include certain off-street communal parking to ensure that a certain 9 number of spaces include an electric vehicle charging station under certain circumstances; requiring certain communal parking spaces to be marked in a certain 10 manner; requiring a certain builder or builder's agent to give to certain buyers and 11 prospective buyers notice of certain options and information about certain rebate 12 13 programs under certain circumstances; providing for the application of this Act; defining certain terms; and generally relating to electric vehicle charging and new 14 residential construction. 15

- 7 (2) "ELECTRIC VEHICLE" MEANS A VEHICLE THAT USES ELECTRICITY 8 FOR PROPULSION.
- 9 (3) "ELECTRIC VEHICLE CHARGING STATION" MEANS A CONNECTED 10 POINT IN AN ELECTRICAL WIRING INSTALLATION AT WHICH CURRENT IS TAKEN TO
- 11 CHARGE A BATTERY OR ANY OTHER ENERGY STORAGE DEVICE IN AN ELECTRIC
- 12 VEHICLE.
- 13 (4) "LEVEL 2 CHARGING" MEANS A LEVEL 2 ELECTRIC VEHICLE 14 CHARGING LEVEL AS DEFINED BY SAE INTERNATIONAL'S J1772 STANDARD.
- 15 (5) "VEHICLE" HAS THE MEANING STATED IN § 11–176 OF THE 16 TRANSPORTATION ARTICLE.
- 17 **(B)** THIS SECTION APPLIES ONLY TO THE CONSTRUCTION OF NEW HOUSING 18 UNITS, INCLUDING:
- 19 (1) SINGLE-FAMILY DETACHED HOMES; AND
- 20 (2) TOWN HOUSES; AND
- 21 (3) MULTIFAMILY RESIDENTIAL BUILDINGS.
- 22 (C) IF THE CONSTRUCTION OF ONE OR MORE NEW HOUSING UNITS WILL
- 23 INCLUDE AT LEAST ONE GARAGE, CARPORT, OR DRIVEWAY FOR EACH HOUSING
- 24 UNIT, THE CONSTRUCTION SHALL THE BUILDER OR THE BUILDER'S AGENT SHALL
- 25 PROVIDE EACH BUYER OR PROSPECTIVE BUYER WITH THE OPTION TO INCLUDE IN
- 26 OR ON EACH THE GARAGE, CARPORT, OR DRIVEWAY:
- 27 (1) AN ELECTRIC VEHICLE CHARGING STATION CAPABLE OF 28 PROVIDING AT LEAST LEVEL 2 CHARGING; OR
- 29 (2) A DEDICATED ELECTRIC LINE OF SUFFICIENT VOLTAGE TO
- 30 SUPPORT THE LATER ADDITION OF AN ELECTRIC VEHICLE CHARGING STATION
- 31 CAPABLE OF PROVIDING AT LEAST LEVEL 2 CHARGING.

3	BUT WILL INCLUDE OFF-STREET COMMUNAL PARKING, THE CONSTRUCTION SHALL
4	ENSURE THAT AT LEAST ONE COMMUNAL PARKING SPACE FOR EACH 25
5	RESIDENTIAL UNITS FEATURES AN ELECTRIC VEHICLE CHARGING STATION
6	CAPABLE OF PROVIDING AT LEAST LEVEL 2 CHARGING.
7	(2) COMMUNAL PARKING SPACES FEATURING ELECTRIC VEHICLE
8	CHARGING STATIONS SHALL BE MARKED AS INTENDED FOR ELECTRIC VEHICLE
9	CHARGING ONLY.
10 11	(D) THE BUILDER OR BUILDER'S AGENT SHALL GIVE TO EACH BUYER OR PROSPECTIVE BUYER:
12 13	(1) NOTICE OF THE OPTIONS LISTED IN SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION; AND
14 15 16	(2) SPECIFIC INFORMATION ABOUT ANY AVAILABLE REBATE PROGRAMS RELATED TO THE PURCHASE OR INSTALLATION OF ELECTRIC VEHICLE CHARGING STATIONS.
17 18 19 20	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall be construed to apply only prospectively and may not be applied or interpreted to have any effect on or application to any new construction for which a building permit is issued before the effective date of this Act.
21 22	SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2020.
