- 16 Beginning in fiscal year 2019, in addition to the grant provided 17 under paragraph (2) of this subsection, the College shall receive the amounts specified under this paragraph. 18
- 19 (ii) For each fiscal year, the State shall provide to the College funds to pay for the increase in State-supported health insurance costs of the College. 20
- 21For each fiscal year in which the State provides a cost-of-living (iii) adjustment for State employees, the State shall provide to the College [50%] 100% of the 22 23 cost-of-living adjustment wage increase for State-supported employees of the College.

- 1 (iv) For each fiscal year in which the State provides funds to other 2 public senior higher education institutions to moderate undergraduate resident tuition 3 increases, it is the intent of the General Assembly that the State shall provide to the College 4 funds for the same purpose.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 6  $\,$  1, 2020.
